

How to Sign up for a Language Proficiency Exam

Step 1: Go to languagetesting.com

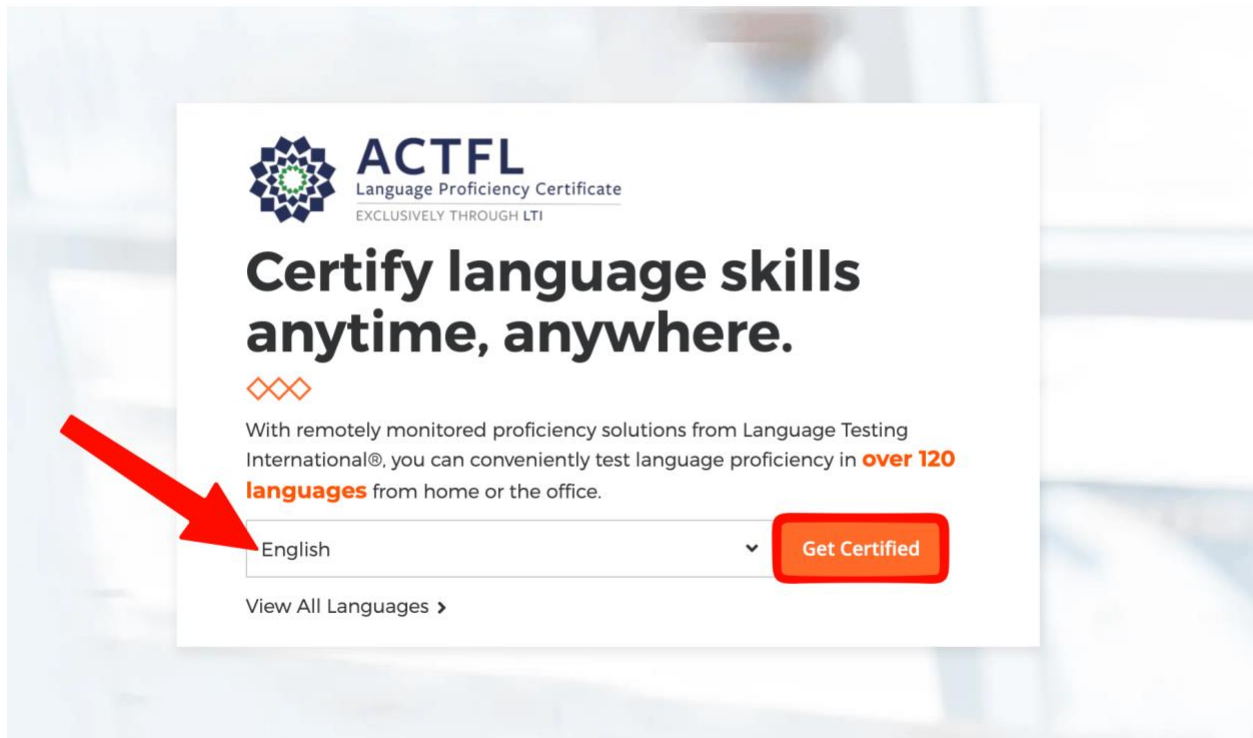
Open up a web browser and navigate to languagetesting.com

Step 2: Enter test language

Enter in the **language** you will be tested on in the text box, then select **Get Certified**. If you will be taking a Spanish assessment, choose **Spanish**.

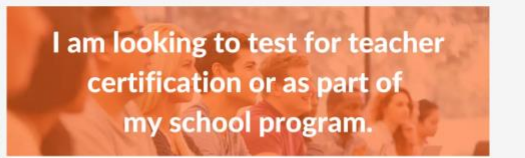

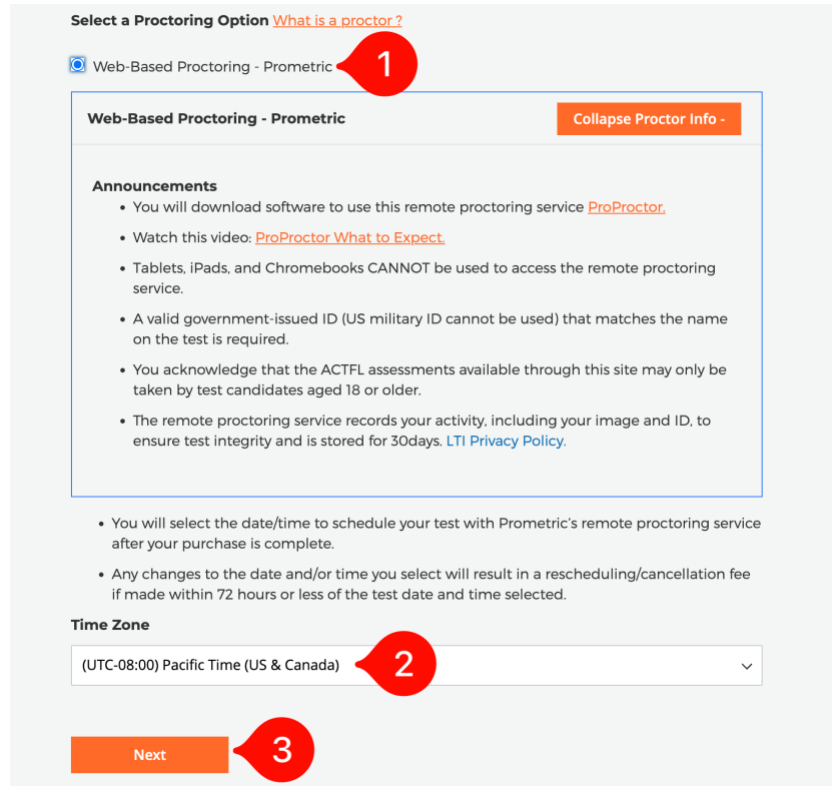

Step 6: Select a proctoring option and checkout

1. Select the **Web-based Proctoring** option, then choose your **time zone** in the dropdown. Once ready, select **Next**.

4. Please fill out your billing and payment information to check out, and ensure you have selected the correct test and proctoring option.
5. After paying for your test, you will receive a confirmation number through your email. Enter your confirmation number and last name in the ProProctor service.
6. Select a date and time to schedule your test.

Important Proctoring Information - Please Read

- You will need to download the ProProctor software to take the test remotely.
- You cannot use a tablet, iPad, or Chromebook. You must use a supported computer.
- You will need a valid government-issued photo ID.
- The name on your ID must match the name registered for your test.
- A U.S. military ID cannot be used.
- You must be 18 years of age or older to take the ACTFL assessment.
- Your testing session will be monitored and recorded, including your image and ID, to protect test integrity.
- The recorded information is stored for 30 days.
- After your purchase is complete, you will select your actual test date and time through Prometric's remote proctoring service.
- If you change your test date or time 72 hours or less before your scheduled appointment, a rescheduling or cancellation fee may apply.
